#### Senior Healthcare Support Worker Apprenticeship - Diagnostic Imaging Support Option - Consultation open

The Senior Healthcare Support Worker Trailblazer Group are pleased to announce that they have opened a consultation on the draft Diagnostic Imaging Option part of the Level 3 Senior Healthcare Support Worker apprenticeship standard.

Please note the purpose of this consultation is to gather feedback on the content of the Diagnostic Imaging Support option which is currently in draft. The core is not currently in review.

This consultation opened on Wednesday 5th October and will close at 12pm on Wednesday 16th November.

Nursing Associate to General Practice Nurse Funding - October 2022

NHS England have expanded the list of roles that are eligible for funding under the Additional Roles Reimbursement Scheme (ARRS). This now includes reimbursing training time for Nursing Associates to become General Practice Nurses.

#### Looking After You Too – coaching for NHS staff from ethnic minority backgrounds this Black History Month

The theme for this year's <u>Black History</u> <u>Month</u> is time for change: action not words and this can mean taking steps to take care of ourselves too.

'Looking After You Too' (LAYT) coaching is a national one-to-one wellbeing support offer for people from ethnic minority backgrounds working in the NHS (both clinical and non-clinical).

The scheme is open to anyone from an ethnic minority background working in the NHS, is confidential and free of charge. Coaching sessions are provided by independent trained coaches from ethnic minority backgrounds who can help us to develop strategies to manage and maintain our wellbeing.

No details are shared with employers and the sessions provide a safe and judgement-free space to deal with difficult conversations and build our resilience.


#### **Diagnostic Radiographer apprenticeship standard - Case Study**

#### Maternity Support Workforce Apprenticeships Procurement -Provider Webinar – Monday 7th November 2022 at 11.30am – 12.30pm

This webinar will be facilitated by HEE to provide apprenticeship providers an overview of the purpose of the maternity support workforce programme and the procurement opportunity (Invite to Tender to go live end of October 2022).

HEE is seeking high quality training providers to develop and deliver Healthcare Support Worker Level 2, Senior Healthcare Supporter Worker Level 3, and Assistant Practitioner Level 5 apprenticeship programmes for Maternity Support Workers.

We want to create high quality development pathways that is underpinned by the <u>Maternity Support Worker Competency, Education and Career Development</u> <u>Framework</u>, and supports maternity support workers to deliver outstanding patient care, and progress their careers without barriers.

#### The procurement for this will go live end of October 2022

This tender is specific to the delivery of the revised apprenticeship standards. This should not, however, prevent apprenticeship providers from showcasing their expertise and activity around the delivery of the current version of the standards.

With a steer from professional bodies, HEE are working with Salisbury Procurement Services to create a framework of providers with a demonstrable record of high-quality apprenticeship provision (including having an overall rating of Ofsted Good or higher), and who will work collaboratively, via implementation groups facilitated by HEE to develop these clinical apprenticeship programmes.

This piece of work is part of a national project led by HEE to support the development of the maternity support workforce. This procurement will not be repeated and is the first stage of a largescale national project which aims to achieve at scale apprenticeship implementation working across all NHS Trusts and other partners nationally. After the procurement is complete, there will be a number of task and finish groups where all providers, a range of employers, maternity profession leads / specialists, professional bodies and other key stakeholders will be working collaboratively to shape consistent and streamlined Level 2, Level 3 and Level 5 apprenticeship provision that is fit for purpose for the maternity support workforce. This will include mapping the Level 2, Level 3 and Level 5 provision to the maternity competency framework.



#### General Practice Nurses (GPNs) now included in the General Practice Fellowship Scheme

#### The eligibility criteria for the General Practice

Fellowship Scheme has been expanded to include nurses new to general practice. The inclusion of new to general practice nurses will provide support to accelerate their clinical and professional development in primary care, further incentivise this career route and support those more experienced nurses to transition, ensuring these professionals feel valued and are best able to contribute to the wider workforce.

In addition, primary care will be provided access to staff who bring experience in a range of conditions which the portfolio offer would allow them to further develop. Nurses that are interested should discuss with their practice manager or their local training hub contact.

### The mental health nurse's handbook

The mental health nurse's handbook is a resource for mental health nurses and their employers to guide their preceptorship and supervision conversations, helping to focus on some key areas of practice. 


