TRAVEL HEALTH

- This interactive session will provide an introduction to Travel Health, including effective risk assessments, the application of evidence-based practice and vaccinepreventable diseases. This course will provide an overview of NHS and private travel vaccines and their associated schedules, with a focus on the UK schedule and catch-up programmes relevant to current outbreaks. Throughout the session, learners will gain an understanding of Yellow Fever and associated certificate requirements under International Health Regulations, Malaria and Malaria Prophylaxis and insect bite transmitted diseases. The course aims to provide Nurses and/or Nurse Associates with the knowledge to effectively undertake travel risk assessments for patients and manage complex situations with application of guidance.



PROSTAP & ZOLADEX

- 1.5 hours Suitable for healthcare professionals wishing to develop the skills and knowledge to administer Prostap and Zoladex
- Learn the theory and develop the practical skills to enable the administration of both hormonal therapies.

The training will consist of theoretical knowledge, practice-based scenarios and the NICE guidelines encompassing common gynaecological conditions, abnormal discharge, common and sexually transmitted infections and the role of the nurse in primary care.





CONTRACEPTION £150

- Full day Suitable for Practice Nurses or Nurse Associates new to primary care or those Nurses who wish to expand their knowledge in Contraception.
- Includes: An overview in effective counselling, Gillick competence/Fraser guidelines and legal issues surrounding contraception and the delivery of services. The session will cover method specific contraception including long-acting-reversiblecontraception (LARC), mode of action, health risks and non-contraceptive benefits with particular focus on initiation of contraception, reviews and guidance related to missed pills or late contraceptive use and pregnancy risk in line with the Faculty of Sexual Reproductive Healthcare guidance. The session will aim to promote an understanding of emergency contraception and when to initiate. The training will consist of theoretical knowledge, practice-based scenarios and application of the UK medical eligibility criteria (UKMEC).
